




Sponsored Program Costs By Major Source **FY05**






TREND ANALYSIS OF SPONSORED PROGRAMS DIRECT COSTS

Sparked by 77% RI growth, Institute Direct Costs are up \$108 Million (60%) ...




Sponsored Program By Major Source Direct Costs FY05




COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING FY05 Direct Costs





Number of Projects/Sub-projects as of June 30, 2005









FY05 Graduate Student Tuition Remission Recoveries




Sponsored Program By Major Source FY05 Facilities & Administrative Cost Recoveries

GIT's growth fueled by \$8.6 Million (65%) rise in College of Engineering Recoveries







FY05 Facilities & Administrative Cost Recoveries




FY05 Facilities & Administrative Cost Recoveries

COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING FY05 Facilities & Administrative Cost Recoveries


